

ARTHURIAN LEGENDS GAME DIRECTOR WORKSHOP UK 2018

Glastonbury, January 2nd-9th 2018



Come with us to Glastonbury on a journey to a world of legends. Discover with us the traces that the stories about Camelot and the famous Knights of the Round Table left in and around the old city. Together we will create a classic medieval chivalry game setting and an exciting adventure that we can then run in a player event a year later. In order to stay true to the old tales we will do some research together. We will also do a series of our famous GD workshops in which we train creating engaging scenes, playing non-player characters in an exciting way, pacing, and many other useful aspects of running a game.

This event takes place from January 2nd -9th 2018 in Glastonbury, UK and includes flights, accommodations, food, and transportation in the UK. Allow a day before and after the event for travel. Your contribution towards cost is only $50 \in (40 \in \text{ for Dragon Legion members})$. We cover the rest.



Why do we run Game Director Workshops?

The Dragon Legion has been using role-playing games for intercultural learning since 2014. We are running big role-playing events with several gaming groups that play in a joint adventure. The groups are linked so that actions of one group have an impact on the others. The setting we play in always explores the mythology and the history of the places we go to, and we try to incorporate the landscape or ancient ruins into the game so that players get a feeling for the place we take them to in the game. Since our events have become more and more popular we are in need of more people who can run these games. We also want to spread the approach and teach those who work with youths how to run their own games. For this reason we have launched our series of Game Director workshops.



Game Director workshops are always divided into two parts: Game Director Training and Game Creation. In the training sessions we teach participants how to run a game well. We focus on different topics such as how to use sound to create atmosphere in games, how to design exciting scenes, how to deal with difficult moments when running a game, etc. Our training sessions always consist of a mixture of theoretical input, group work/discussions and practical exercises. In the Game Creation part of the event we do research together and we create a setting as well as an adventure.

LOCATION

We will be staying at the Travelodge in Glastonbury (three people per room, mixed nationalities). We will spend the days at a meeting room in the city center within walking distance of the main attractions.
